DEPUTY MINISTER MAKWETLA TO BRING WARMTH AND MOBILITY TO THE COMMUNITY OF BREYTON

The Deputy Minister of Justice and Correctional Services, Mr. Thabang Makwetla, will visit the Siyanqoba Orphanage Centre in Breyton (near Ermelo) in Mpumalanga on Monday 18 July 2016. Accompanied by the Msukaligwa Municipality Mayor, Cllr Siphongwe, Deputy Minister Makwetla, will be joined by offenders, and other stakeholders to dedicate 67 minutes refurbishing the centre.
