### **Nkosi Holomisa brings technology to Mqanduli learners**

Deputy Minister of Justice and Correctional Services, Nkosi Phathekile Holomisa, will hand over 120 tablet devices to three rural schools in Mqanduli, King Sabatha Dalindyebo Local Municipality, Eastern Cape, on Thursday, 17 February 2021.

The tablet devices will promote digitised learning and enable learners to access technology. They were donated by MTN and will benefit learners in Corhana Primary School, Ngqiniko Primary School and Mxambule Primary School.

The devices will improve the quality of education for learners and enhance their performance. This is part of MTN's goal of ensuring that learners in rural areas become part of a modern connected life.

School principals in Mqanduli last year approached Nkosi Holomisa to intervene as they were confronted with challenges of poor network coverage and lack of modern technology tools.

Nkosi Holomisa approached MTN which then intervened with 30 tablet devices and promised to deliver more in the New Year (2022).

MTN has over the years donated multi media centres across the country, more in particular at remote and rural areas.
