



 - 5. Healing garden for posttraumatic stress disorder



EFFECTIVE PAROLE PROCESS

- The South African parole system need an urgent attention.
- ► The composition of the parole board must be revisited, including the process before the parole hearing.
- ► The legislative framework related, specifically, section 74-78 must be reviewed.
- A comprehensive legal framework must be designed, involving all the stakeholders.
- A point-system must be developed to ensure that reoffending inmates are not eligible for parole in future.
