DEFINING SELF-SUFFICIENCY

- Self sufficiency is being defined as the extent to which the department is providing in its own needs with regard to production workshops and agricultural production versus the total needs for the specific items.
- To enhance: existing self-sufficiency and sustainability projects
- To enhance the distribution route of self produced products amongst regions.
- To establish new enterprises/projects and expansion of existing projects to ensure self-sufficiency and sustainability in the department.



DISCUSSION

R27 699 000 was allocated to Dir PWA in 2022/2023 for: recapitalization of machinery and equipment replacement of old/unproductive breeding animals procurement of Computers for big farms, i.e.

- Plant Production R10 601 000
- Animal Production R 4 603 000
- Production Workshops R 12 255 000
- Computers R240 000
